

# **CARE INSTRUCTIONS**

Karpenter's solid wood furniture has a durability and strong characteristic to make indoor furniture. Since it is a natural material, some cracking or movement on wood may occur, please be acknowledged that it is normal adaptation to the furniture's environment.

This guide provides recommendation on the best ways to care and preserve your solid wood furniture that keep the longevity and durability.



#### **EARLY STEP TREATMENT**

When you are first receiving the furniture with oil-based finish, there might be any residue on its surface. Please use a clean and soft cloth and wipe down the surface of the wood. Within the first one week after the furniture open and placed, it is the best to not placing too many items on the furniture surfaces. This will allow the finish to cure thoroughly and acclimate to the environment of your place.

### **REGULAR CARE**

- For regular maintenance, use a dry cloth to clean the dust.
- For quick cleans ups, a soft damp cloth will suffice to clean it up. In case of a spill, use a damp cloth and natural soap.
- Wipe in the direction of the grain.
- Please don't uses soap that containing detergent and chemical.
- Should need to use cleaners, please use a cleaner with a neutral PH to maintain the furniture over time

# **POINTS TO REMEMBER**

- 1. To prevent color differences, do not place the furniture in direct sunlight and move objects placed on the furniture from time to time.
- 2. To prevent staining, we recommend that any spill be removed immediately.
- 3. When cleaning the surface, always work in the direction of the wood grain.
- 4. Use placements and/or coasters to prevent hot pots and pans, or cold glasses and bottles, from leaving marks on the furniture.
- 5. Do not drag the furniture along the floor; always lifts the furniture when moving.

We do offer two types of coating; Oil-based and Water-based finish to compliment the natural look of its solid wood. The finishing process is achieved with a high quality finishing in order to magnifying the characteristic of the wood.



## **OIL-BASED FINISH**

Oil-based finish offers more color depth and shine. They're simple to apply and easy to maintain. Oil-based finishes is highlighting the rustic feel and warmth vibes of the wood.

#### WATER-BASED FINISH

Water-based finish expresses clear and natural color of the furniture. This Water-based finishing that we use tends to be quick dry yet still embracing the natural beauty of solid wood.
